What is an Ambassador for the Greater Tallahassee Chamber of Commerce?

The Ambassadors are a group of members who volunteer their time to serve as brand representatives for the Chamber and its services. Recognizing that our members are the backbone of the organization, Ambassadors work to provide greater visibility for new members while supporting, encouraging, and spreading goodwill among existing members.

Ambassadors promote the Chamber by being knowledgeable about member benefits, recommending resources, and fostering relationships. Whether volunteering at events, posting on social media, or giving back to the community, Ambassadors play a critical role in boosting the identity of the Chamber and cultivating its deep roots in the community.

Ambassador Benefits

- a. Heightened visibility and expanded recognition for each Ambassador within the Chamber and community as a result of attending ribbon cuttings, grand openings, and Chamber events.
- b. Professional networking opportunity
- c. Competitive "Ambassador of the Year" recognition at Annual Chamber Breakfast Meeting
- d. Increased access to community and business leaders as a result of involvement
- e. Select events can be attended free of charge when acting as an official Chamber Ambassador - wearing your red jacket. (Business After Hours)

Ambassador Purpose and Responsibilities

- a. Ambassadors will serve in actively promoting the Chamber's vision, mission, and strategic priorities.
- b. Ambassadors will assist in welcoming new members through calls, emails, and delivering "welcome bags."
- c. Ambassadors will assist in retaining current members and encouraging their involvement in Chamber committees, events, and programs.
- d. Ambassadors will serve as Chamber representatives at ribbon cuttings, grand openings, breakfasts, luncheons, and other community events.
- e. Ambassadors will actively communicate on social media, helping to promote the Chamber and its fellow members.
- f. Ambassadors will adhere to social media guidelines provided by the Chamber.
- g. The Ambassadors will regularly meet on the 2nd Monday of each month from 3:30-4:30pm.

Selection Qualifications

To help you determine whether the Ambassador role is right for you, consider the following critical attributes we are looking for:

- Effective Communication
 - Passion for Building and Growing Relationships
 - A high level of Professionalism
 - Team Player willing to serve in a variety of ways
- a. Ambassador membership is limited to persons who are members in good standing or employed by members in good standing with the Greater Tallahassee Chamber of Commerce.
 - b. Ambassadors should demonstrate the commitment to the mission and goals of the Chamber, flexibility in the workday, and willingness to volunteer their time and effort.
 - c. Ambassadors shall make every effort to attend the monthly meetings and scheduled events. Attendance will be recorded each month. If a member is unable to attend, it is their responsibility to inform the Chamber Ambassador Coordinator.
 - d. If an Ambassador can no longer fulfill their obligation, they must notify the Chamber Ambassador Coordinator.
