## Overview of CareerSource Capital Region Not Seasonally Adjusted July 21, 2023

- The unemployment rate in CareerSource Capital Region (Gadsden, Leon, and Wakulla counties) was 3.3 percent in June 2023. This rate was equal to the region's year ago rate of 3.3 percent. The region's June 2023 unemployment rate was 0.3 percentage point above the state rate of 3.0 percent. The labor force was 200,093, up 5,643 (+2.9 percent) over the year. There were 6,584 unemployed residents in the region.
- Wakulla County had the lowest unemployment rate (2.9 percent) in CareerSource Capital Region followed by Leon County (3.3 percent) and Gadsden County (3.8 percent).

## **Tallahassee Metro Area**

- In June 2023, nonagricultural employment in the Tallahassee MSA was 193,400, an increase of 4,800 jobs (+2.5 percent) over the year.
- The Leisure and Hospitality (+6.1 percent); Other Services (+3.4 percent); and Information (+2.6 percent) industries grew faster in the metro area than statewide over the year.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year were Education and Health Services (+1,500 jobs); Government (+1,400 jobs); Leisure and Hospitality (+1,200 jobs); Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (+500 jobs); Other Services (+300 jobs); Mining, Logging, and Construction (+100 jobs); and Information (+100 jobs).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were Professional and Business Services (-200 jobs) and Manufacturing (-100 jobs).
- The Financial Activities industry was unchanged in jobs over the year.
